



Camp Kit List No. 1

Winter Indoors

Sleeping Bag / Old Duvet	Jumper or Sweat Shirts
Sleeping Mat (if instructed)	Waterproof Trousers and Jacket
Pillow	Torch and spare batteries
PJ's	Warm Hat
Towel	Water Bottle
Toiletries	65-75 Ltr Rucksack or similar
Trousers (and spares)	£10 Max Pocket Money
T-Shirts (and spares)	Sturdy footwear or hiking boots
Warm Jacket	Indoor shoes or slippers
Warm Socks (and spares)	Arrive on Camp in full Uniform

All Items of clothing must be clearly labelled with the Scouts name

All above must fit in or on the Scouts rucksack or bag. The Scout must be able carry all his/her own equipment with no help from leaders or parents unless a medical or disability prevents this. Remember we have three man tents to get three Scouts in plus baggage so excessive equipment is not welcome.

Mobile phones are **NOT ALLOWED**, failure to comply to this request will result in your Scout not attending the next camp and the phone confiscated, a suitable donation of £2 must made to get it back. (There is a genuine reason for no phones please ask)

All medication must be reported to a Leader even if your Scout will have it in their bag and be able to decide for themselves when it's to be taken. If you would like a Leader to ensure it's taken it must be handed to a Leader with written instructions.
